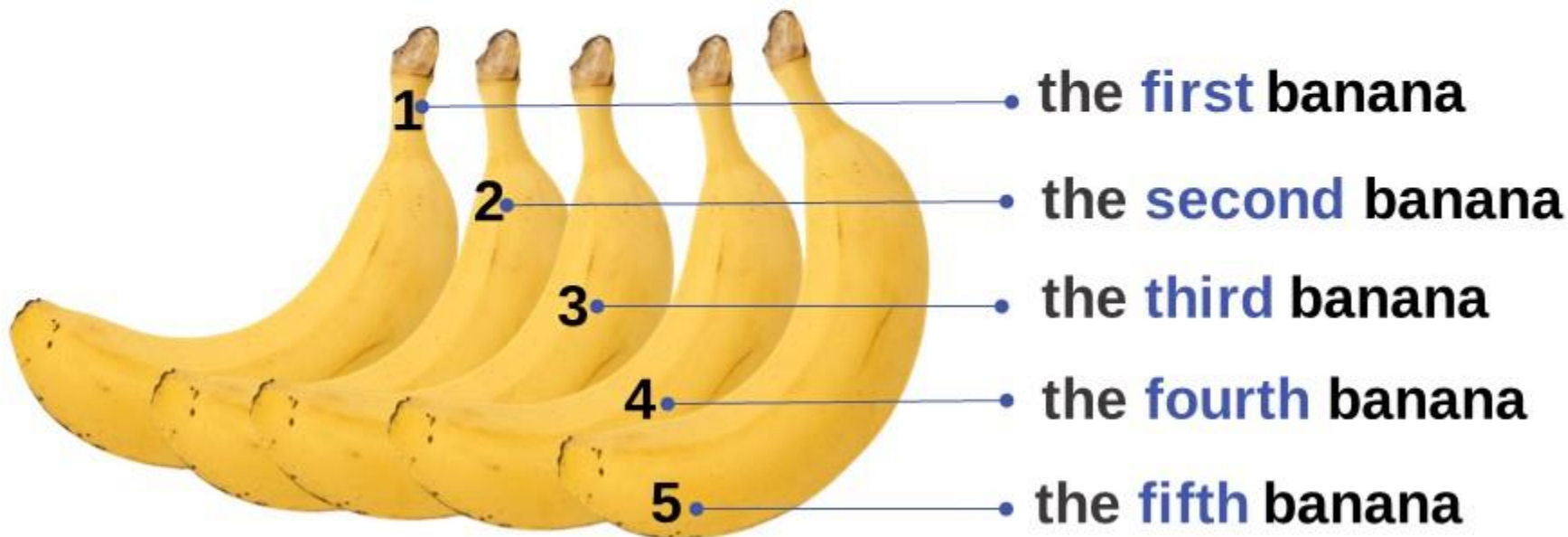

There are five bananas.

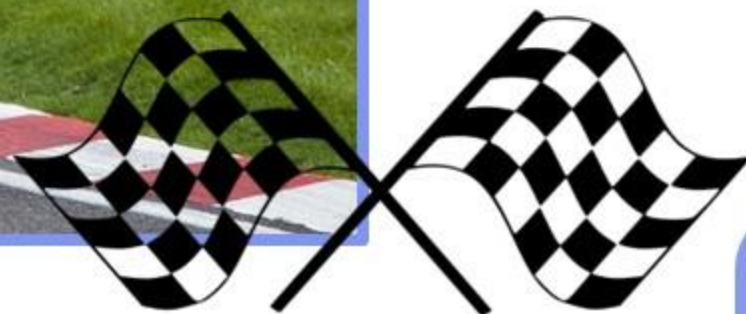

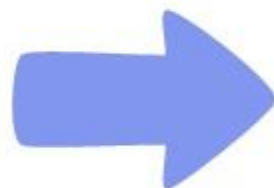

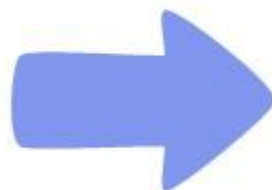
