Verbs are action words.



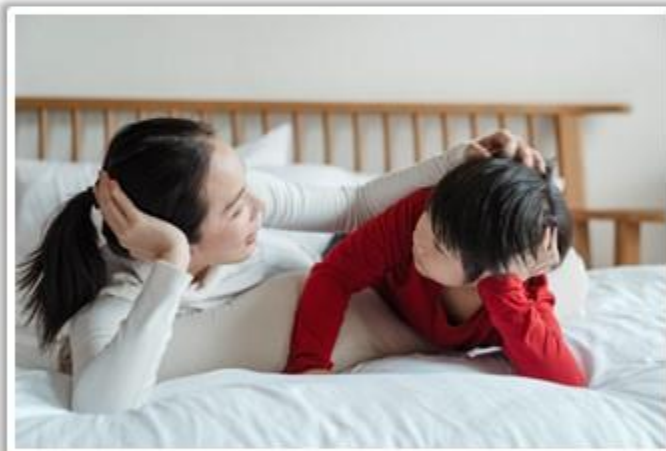

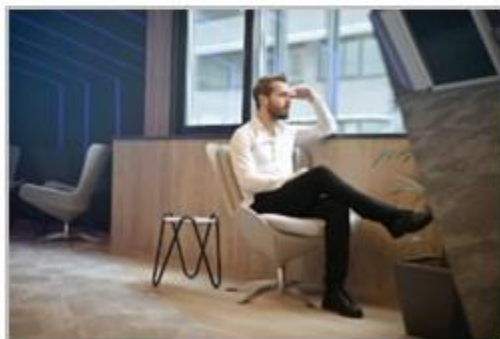
