



transitive verbs

These are verbs that have an object right after them.

transitive verb + object

drink coffee

read a book

watch TV

speak Japanese

Examples:

- 1. The man is drinking coffee.
- 2. You are reading a book.
- 3. They are watching TV.
- 4. I am speaking Japanese.

These are verbs that do not have an object right after them.

intransitive preposition + object verb listen music to speak with my mom think about my job sit a chair on
