






Learn 'an' vs 'a'.

AN + NOUN

۷S

A + NOUN

<u>before</u> a word that starts with a <u>vowel sound</u>. (a, e, i, o, u)

- This is an eraser.
- That is an apple.

<u>before</u> a word that starts with a <u>consonant sound</u>. (b, c, d, f, etc.)

- This is a pen.
- That is a car.



Singular Demonstratives vs Plural Demonstratives

SINGULAR (1) DEMONSTRATIVES vs			PLURAL (2 OR MORE) DEMONSTRATIVES	
THIS	is used to refer to an object near the speaker • This is a pen. • This is a sharpener.	THESE	is used to refer to objects near the speaker • These are pens. • These are sharpeners.	
THAT	 an object <u>far</u> from the speaker That is an eraser. That is a sticky note. 	THOSE	 objects <u>far</u> from the speaker Those are erasers. Those are sticky notes.
