

Opposite Adjectives

two words that express opposing concepts

The horse is fast. The turtle is slow.

The living room is beautiful. The kitchen is ugly.

The elephant is big and the bird is small.



is used to join two sentences together.

Example:

The bird is beautiful. The bird is small.

The bird is beautiful and small.



Learn the sentence structures.

Describing-Nouns

We can put an adjective before or after a noun.

Before Nouns

It + is + adjective + noun

It is a **good book**.

It is a fast car.

It is a **slow car**.

It is a **good cake**.

It is a bad cake.

After Nouns

The + noun + is/ are + adjective

The **book** is **good**.

The car is fast.

The car is slow.

The cake is good.

The cake is bad.
