





### 2 Main Uses of the Apostrophe (')

# Apostrophes 5

1. We add an **Apostrophe S** ('s) for the possessive form of singular nouns. For plural nouns or names that end with an "s", we only add an **apostrophe** (').

name of her <b>father</b>	her father's name
brother of <b>Anna</b>	Anna's brother
book of <b>Thoma<u>s</u></b>	Thomas' book
office of the <b>doctor</b> s	doctors' office

X She's grandfather name is Joe.

X Her's grandfather name is Joe.

✓ Her grandfather's name is Joe.

2. We use an **Apostrophe** (') for contractions.

name is	name's
they are	they're
do not	don't
there is	
is not	


X My names' Aya.
