Countable and Uncountable Nouns

Countable Nouns

- can be counted

Ex: egg, apple, carrot, vegetable, burger, etc.

- have a **Singular** and **Plural** form

one egg, two eggs, three eggs, etc.

one carrot, two carrots, three carrots, etc.

one book, two books, three books, etc.

Grammar Memo 1

Can be used with "**a/an**" and "**some**"



I need **one** apple.
I need **an** apple.



I need **three** apples.
I need **some** apples.

an apple	some apples
an egg	some eggs
a vegetable	some vegetables

Countable and Uncountable Nouns

Uncountable Nouns

- cannot be counted

Ex: meat, flour, milk, butter, bread, etc.

- always in **Singular** form

✗ one meat	✓ meat
✗ two flours	✓ flour
✗ three butters	✓ butter

Grammar Memo 2

Cannot be used with "a/an" but can be used with "some"



- ✗ I need **one** meat.
- ✗ I need **a** meat.
- ✓ I need **some** meat.



- ✗ I have **one** water.
- ✗ I have **a** water.
- ✓ I have **some** water.
