

Used to say it is time to do something that <u>should</u> <u>have been done</u> a long time ago.


It's (high) time + subject + past simple

It's high time we went on a holiday.

It's (high) time + subject + were

It's high time he **were** in bed. It's late.

- It's high time the company changed the policy.
- It's high time the President made some sound decisions.

It's time **to revise** our marketing strategies.

It's (high) time + for + to


It's time **for him to meet** our department heads.

- 2 It's time + for + noun/pronoun
 - It's time for you to buy a new pair of jeans.
 - It's time for her to ask for a raise.
