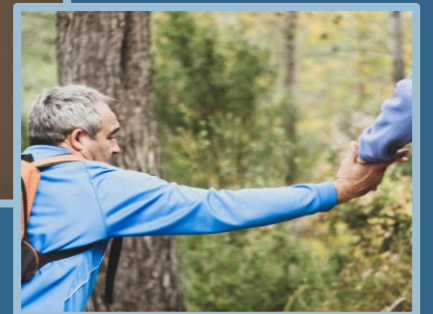

For a lot of people, outer beauty, which is thought to be something you are born with, is considered to be the most important. It is what **stimulates** the mind. For example, when you meet people for the first time, you immediately notice their **physical appearance**, including the clothes they wear.

On the other hand, some say beauty comes from within people's hearts. Inner beauty will last forever and will never fade. In contrast, outer beauty fades over time. A person's **characteristics** or behavior is what others would remember compared to a person's physical appearance.
