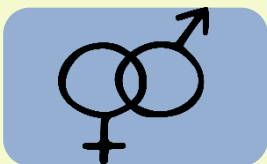
## How important is education?



Basic literacy skills can help 171 million people get out of poverty.



12 million children could be saved from hunger if their mothers had secondary education.



People especially women with secondary education would have more right.

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secondary education : education for children between the ages of 11 and 18

## Read and Answer

In the past 10 years, major progress has been made in access to education. However, there are still many children who do not go to school.

More than 140 million did not have the possibility to take the school-leaving examination. Eventually, they were not **qualified** to enter higher education or to graduate from school.

Some 750 million young people (over 15 years of age) are **illiterate**, and almost two thirds of them are women.

### **qualified**

having passed the exams or completed the training that are necessary in order to do a particular job

### **illiterate**

(of a person) not knowing how to read or write

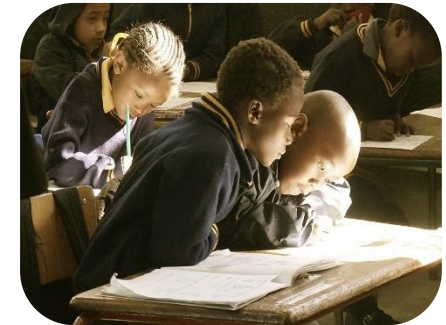


1 CAI

Since 2012, CAI has built four new schools in rural areas of Tajikistan. These schools are safe, warm and sanitary for both girls and boys to study.

2 World Bank

Since its creation in 1944, the organization has invested \$69 billion globally in more than 1,500 educational projects. Recently, the World Bank laid out the "Learning for All" plan which focused on ensuring that all children and youth receive learning opportunities by 2020.

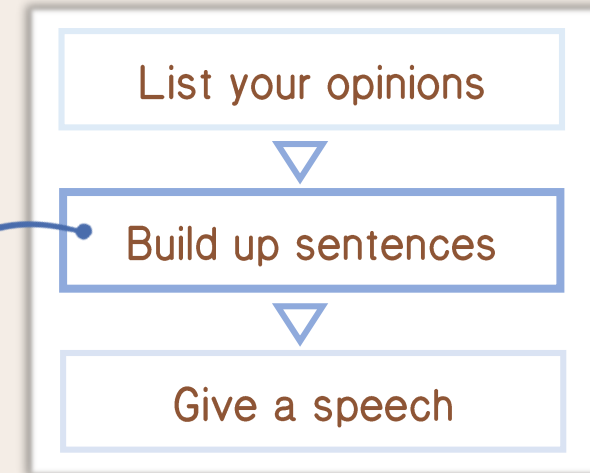
