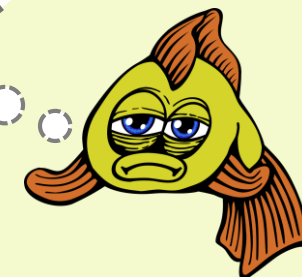

The ocean **absorbs** too much CO₂ from the atmosphere. The dissolved CO₂ makes the ocean become more **acidic**, making it more difficult for coral reef to build shells.

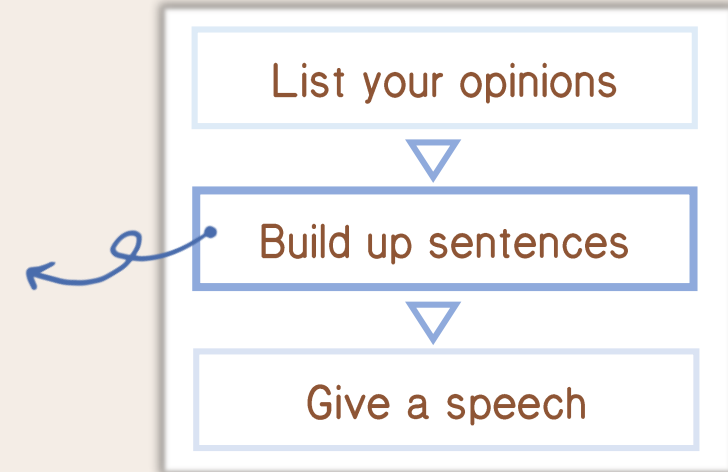
