- 2. Use prepositions of place (on, next to, under, behind, etc.) to describe the placement of different people and objects in the photo. Use phrases to direct the listener's attention to different parts of the photo like: "in the background", "in the foreground", "on the left/right", "in the bottom right corner", "in the center", etc.

Identify the statements that appropriately describe the picture.

Take note of the prepositions and speculative language used.
