- 3. Speculate in moderation and only on what is relevant in the photo. Do not speculate on things that have no evidence.

For example: "I suppose they are cooking lunch since it is very bright in the room." (We can't really say for sure that it is lunch time just based on a room's lighting.)

# **Test-taking tips:**

- 1. When there are a lot of objects in a picture, describe what the people are doing first, then describe the other objects that you see in the background. Put more emphasis on describing people's actions over describing objects.
- 2. If there are many things in the background, there is no need to enumerate and mention every object in the picture.
- 3. Strong adjectives make descriptions more interesting compared to using very + adjectives.

Ex. very good – fantastic

very clean – spotless

very happy - ecstatic


