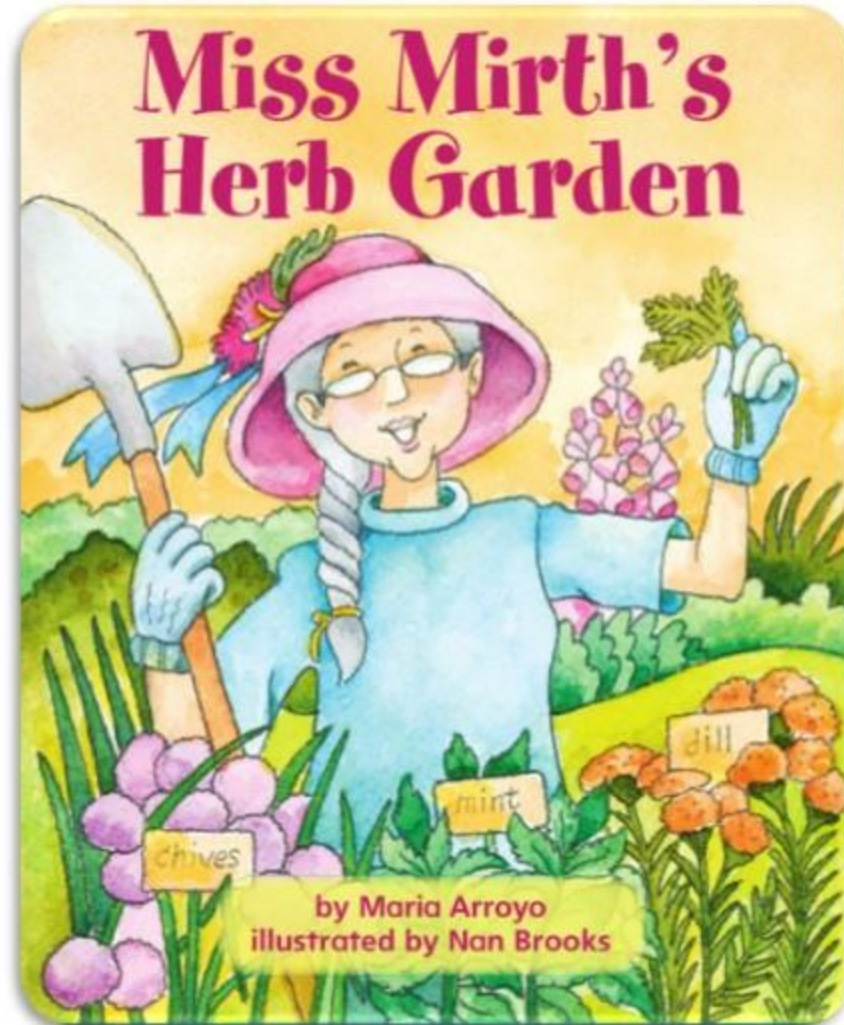

# Reading Time

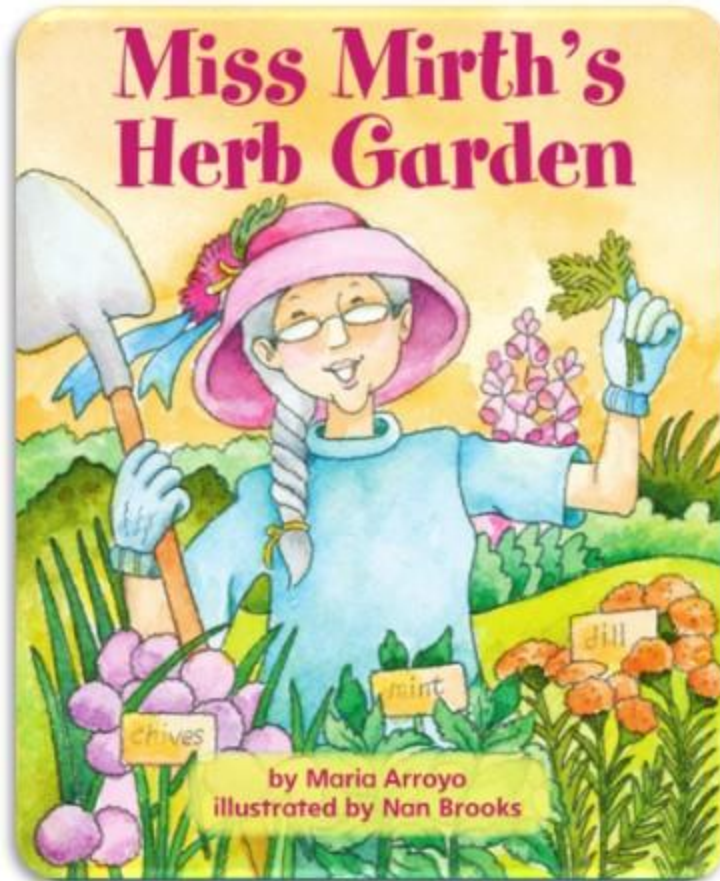


Then lots of people come!
