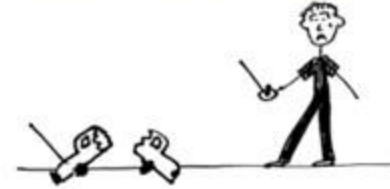

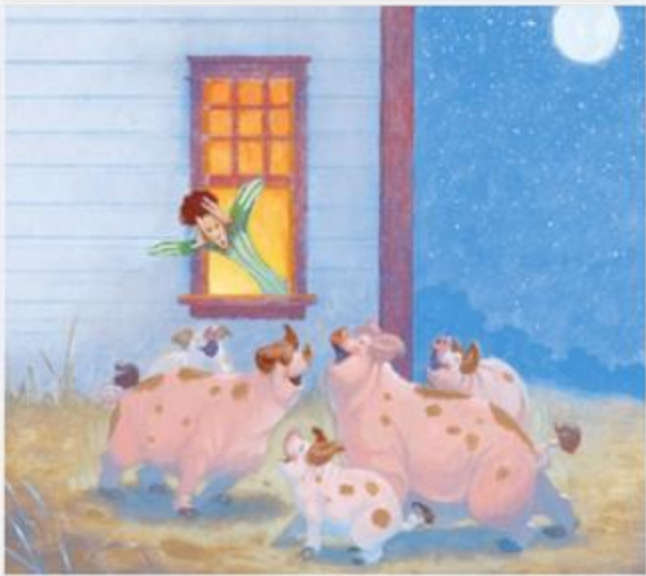
Reading Time
