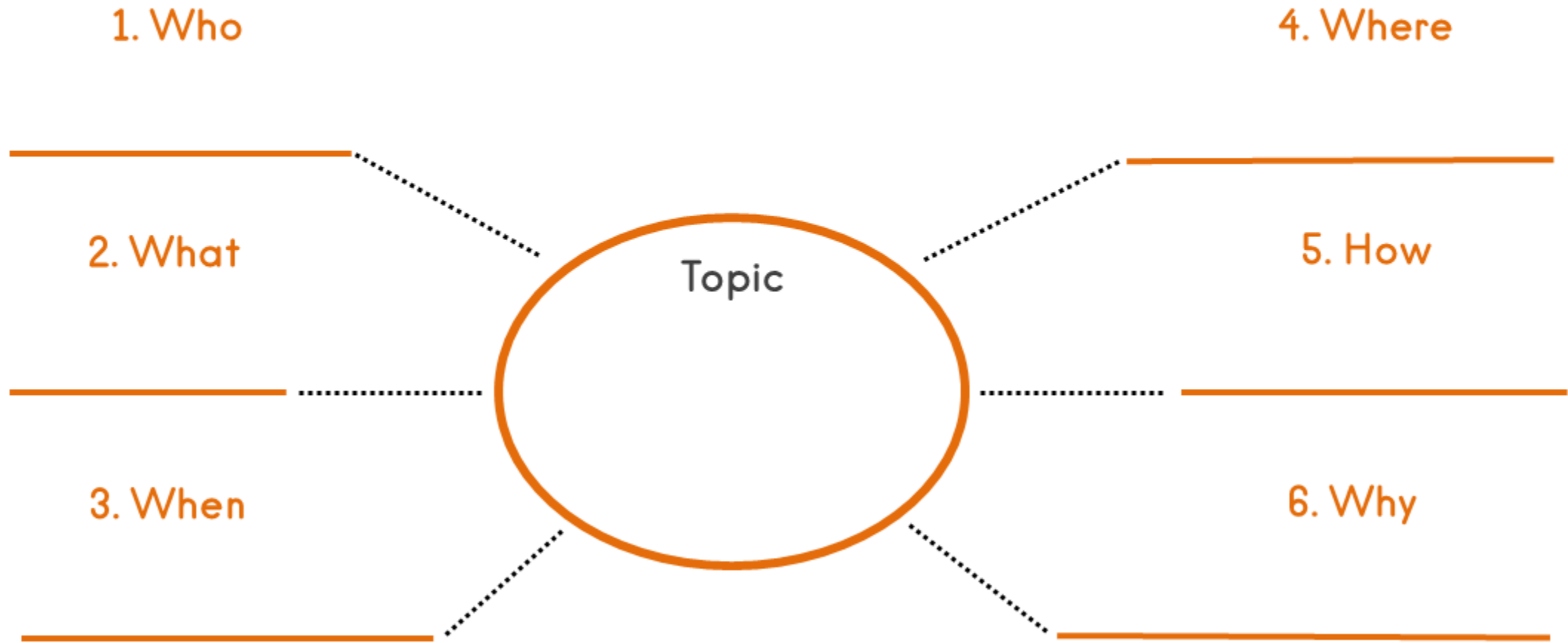

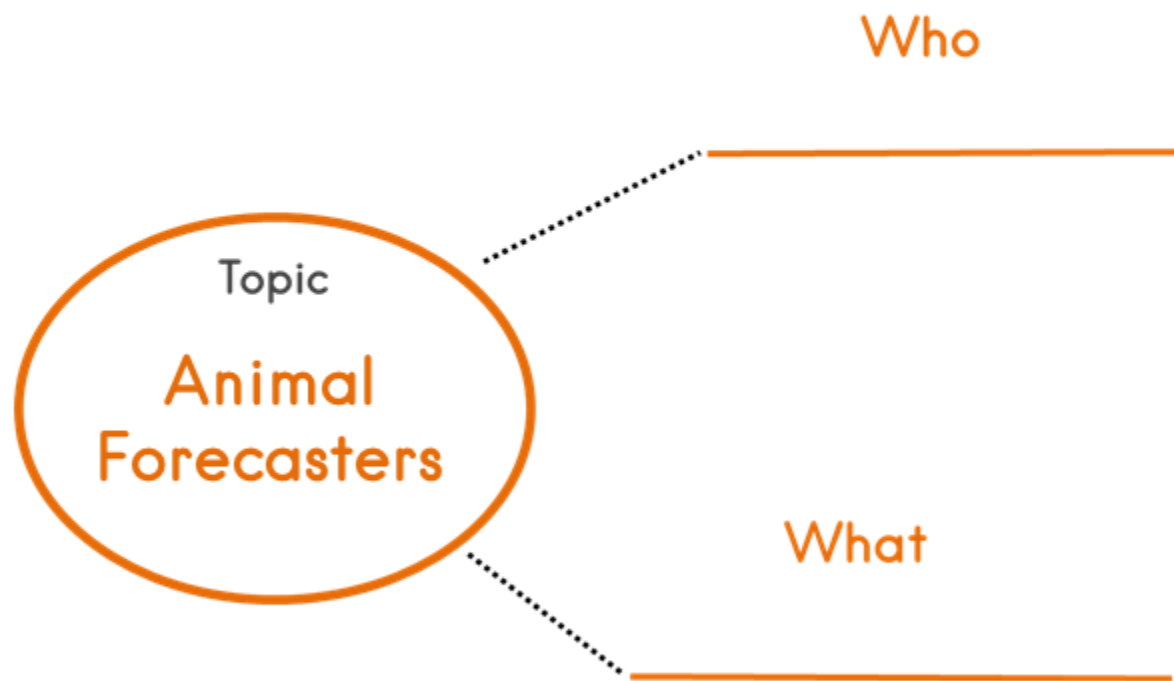
Wh- Question Map

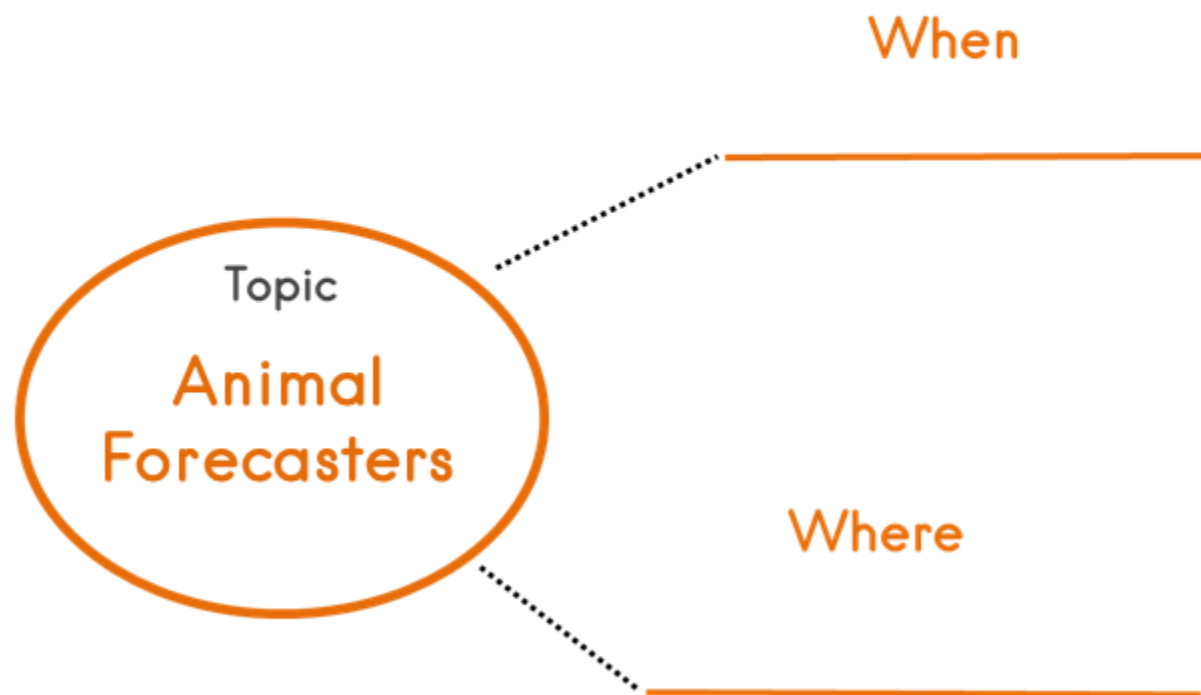


Animal Forecasters | Paragraph 1

Animal Forecasters | Paragraph 3

Animals use a combination of sensory tools such as vision, hearing, and smell to detect changes in their environment. Some animals also have special organs that help them sense changes in temperature, pressure, and humidity. For instance, when cows lie down in a field, it is believed to be a sign of rain or an approaching storm. Bees have been observed to be less active before a storm, as they sense the changes in pressure. ...

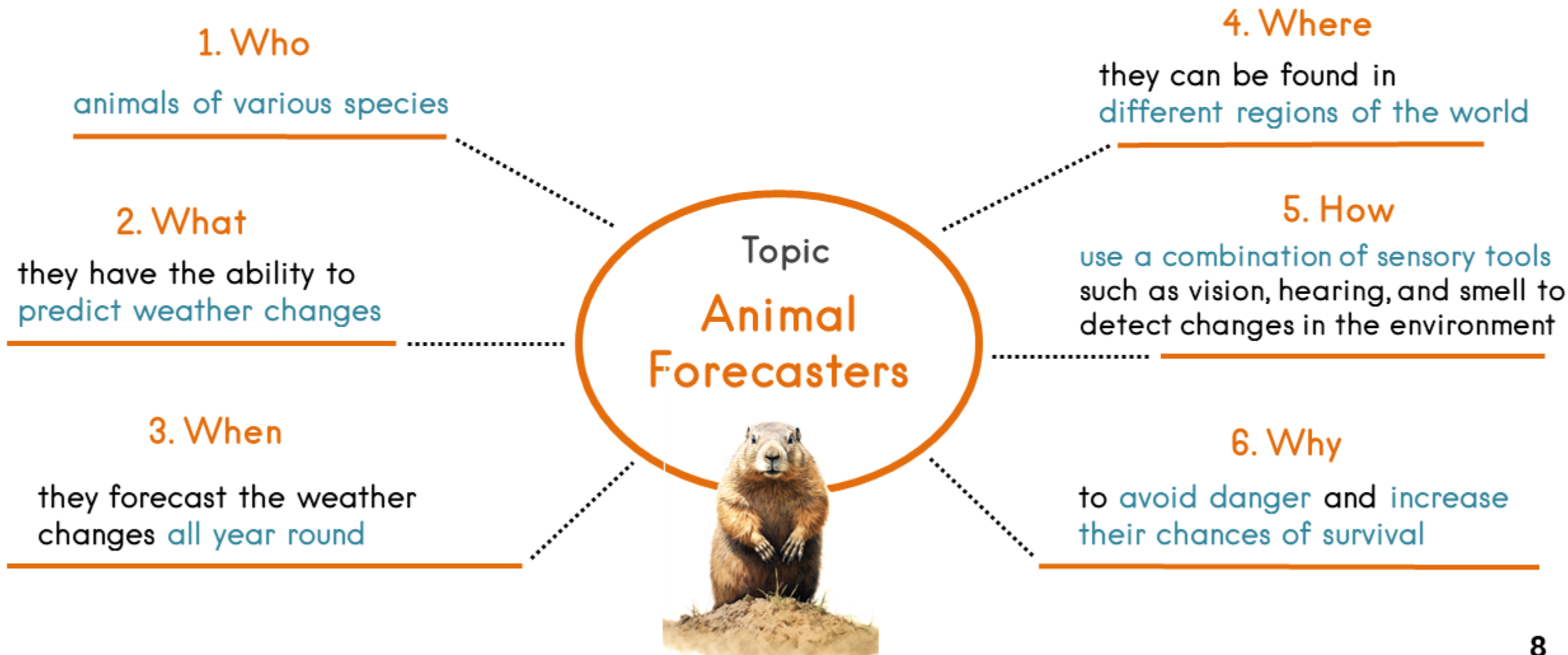

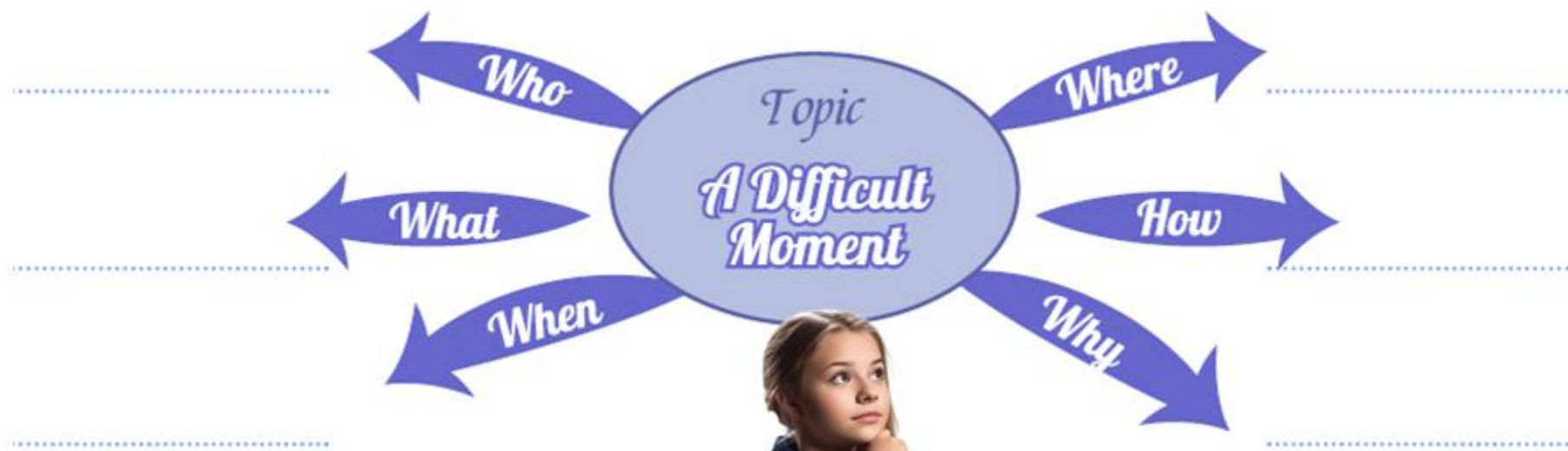
