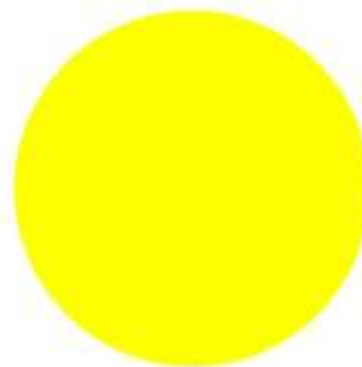
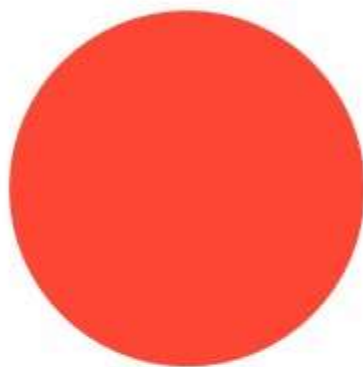

What Colors Mean Part II

Blue is the color of the sky and the sea so it **suggests** calm and peace.

It is a cold color so it is **often** linked to lack of feelings. However, it also suggests trust and responsibility. Many banks choose blue as the color of their **logos**.

Blue is also a sad color. There is a type of music called blues in the US. It's sad music.

suggest – to express an idea

logo – a company's name or symbol

Green is the color of nature. It means life and hope.

Green is the national color of Ireland. The most famous festival in Ireland is St. Patrick's Day and people wear green clothes for the day.

Green is a lucky color. Card tables and **billiards** tables use green.



billiard

- a game for two people played with long sticks and balls on a long table covered with green cloth.

Green means safe and is often used on **safety signs**.

Many environmental groups use green in their logos to show that they care for nature.

In Western countries, green sometimes means **inexperience** and **jealousy**.



safety sign

inexperience – lack of knowledge or skills



jealousy – feeling unhappy that someone has something or someone that you want
