More Manners to Remember

When you are out and about:

- If you bump into someone, say "excuse me."
- Cover your mouth when you cough or sneeze.
- When you go through a door, hold it open for the person who is behind you.
- Don't push through people to get to the front. Wait for your turn.

- Speak quietly on public transport.

public transport

 (People use it to travel from one place to another.)

When you are with other people:

- Don't interrupt when people are speaking.
- Use people's names when you talk to them.
 It makes them feel special.
- Look at someone in the eye when you speak to them. It shows you are interested.
- Don't make fun of other people.

- Don't whisper to a friend when you are with other people.
- Don't ask how much something costs.
