In our last lesson, Robin wrote his first draft by using his Order Chart. Now he is going to revise it.



## What are exciting words?

Exciting words or exclamatory words show emotions.

They are usually followed by an exclamation mark (!).

<sup>,我们也没有</sup>了。





Examples of exclamatory words:

Wow! Great!

Hurray! Amazing!

Bravo!

Nice!



I see! I can put a "Wow!" here!
