Writing a nonfiction book review means talking about a nonfiction book you read.








In the beginning, we write about the title and the author.

The ending tells why you like the book.




Lead-in

Alice wants to write a nonfiction book review. What did she do for prewriting?









What book did she choose?






















We can use these pieces of information to do step 3.

A grasshopper eats the plants. The grasshopper gets bigger.


A mouse eats the grasshopper. The mouse grows bigger.


