The Writing Process of a List Poem:

Revise, Edit & Publish



Revise

For revising, Lily changed the order of the two sentences.



Step 1: Change

Lily makes a change to her poem.

Spaghetti is messy.

Spaghetti is slippery.

Edit

Help Lily check for conventions with the given marks.



Step 2: Check

Lily checks her poem for conventions.

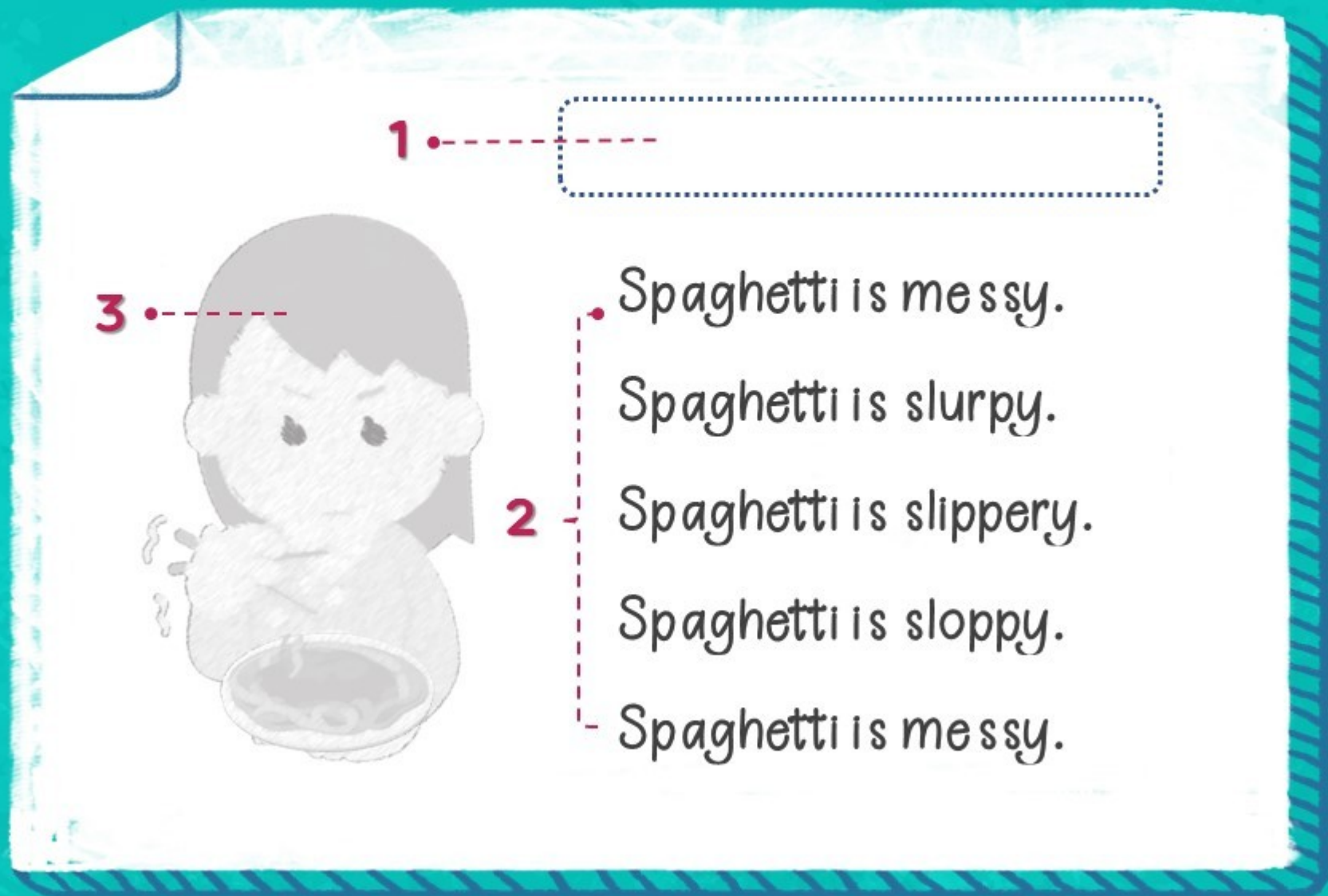
